Exercise 01

Vocabulary

whisper	(N)	to speak very quietly	She whispered a secret to her friend.
probably	(ADV)	likely	I'll probably never finish.
hide	(V)	to put something in a place where it cannot be seen; to keep an information secret	He's hiding a rose behind his back.
hold hands	(Phrase)	to put a hand in another person's hand	They walked down the street holding hands .
in a relationship	(Phrase)	have a boyfriend/girlfriend	You don't have to be in a relationship for you to feel really happy.
revelation	(N)	an information that was a secret but is now made known	That revelation about his real identity has shocked everyone in the family.
secret	(N)	something that only a few people know about	She told me a secret .

For sure! Everyone will envy Anna if this is true. Let's go and ask them.
