Vocabulary

family	(N.)	a group consisting of parents and children living together in a household.	Our family consists of five members.
parent	(N.)	the place where a person lives	He was never to see his parents again.
father	(N.)	a male parent	That is the girl whose father is a doctor.
mother	(N.)	a female parent	She helped her mother clean the house.
brother	(N.)	a man or boy in relation to other sons and daughters of his parents.	My brother and I traveled to Europe last year.
sister	(N.)	a woman or girl in relation to other daughters and sons of her parents.	The girl singing over there is my sister .
older	(ADJ.)	born before someone	I have an older brother.
younger	(ADJ.)	born after someone	I have two younger sisters.
only child	(PHRASE)	someone who has no brothers or sisters	I am an only child .

And my cat, too. My parents and I love him so much.



Bob

That is so nice.
