<b>hobby</b>	(N.)	an activity that you enjoy doing in your free time	My <b>hobby</b> is stamp collecting.
<b>spend time</b>	(PHRASE)	to use time doing something	I enjoy <b>spending time</b> with my family.
<b>leisure time</b>	(N.)	free time	What do you do during your <b>leisure time</b> ?
<b>(be) interested in</b>	(PHRASE)	wanting to learn more about something or to spend more time doing it	She is <b>interested in</b> playing the guitar.
<b>(be) keen on</b>	(PHRASE)	to be very interested in something	He is <b>keen on</b> traveling.
<b>(be) good at</b>	(PHRASE)	to be able to do something well	My mother is <b>good at</b> playing volleyball.
<b>often</b>	(ADV.)	Many times	I <b>often</b> play computer games.
