Exercise 01

Vocabulary

weather	(N.)	the temperature or conditions outside, for example if it is sunny, rainy, hot, cold, etc.	The weather is beautiful today.
chilly	(ADJ.)	cold	It's chilly today.
hat	(N.)	a piece of clothing that you wear on your head to protect from the weather or for fashion	I wear a hat to keep myself warm.
glove	(N.)	a piece of clothing that you wear on your hands to keep them warm	I need gloves to keep my hands from getting cold.
pocket	(N.)	a small bag on a coat, pants etc. used for carrying money, keys and other small things	I usually put my hands inside my pockets .

I agree. Anyway, let's walk. We'll get warmer while walking.

All right, let's get going!
