### Vocabulary

<b>anniversary</b>	(N)	a date on which something important or special happened one or more years ago	Our company celebrated its 20th <b>anniversary</b> .
<b>accessory</b>	(N)	an item that is not needed, but is used to make something more beautiful or useful	My sister's hobby is collecting fashion <b>accessories</b> .
<b>brooch</b>	(N)	a piece of jewelry for women that is fastened onto clothes with a pin	Please help me pin this <b>brooch</b> on my hair.
<b>wrap</b>	(V)	to cover something completely in paper or some other material	The store did a beautiful job of <b>wrapping</b> the gift.
<b>look good on</b>	(PHRASE)	used to say that something suits well to the person wearing it	These earrings <b>look</b> really <b>good on</b> you.

**Clerk**

**Cavid**

I think so, too. She'll be happy with it. I'll take it. Can I pay by card?



**Clerk**

Of course you can. Would you like it wrapped?



**Cavid**

Yes, please. And here's my card.



**Clerk**

Thank you for shopping here. We hope you'll come again.
