#### Vocabulary

<b>sightseeing</b>	(N)	the activity of visiting interesting places that tourists usually visit	I love <b>sightseeing</b> .
<b>postcard</b>	(N)	a card usually with a photo on one side that can be sent by post without an envelope	I'll send you a <b>postcard</b> when I get to Spain.
<b>souvenir</b>	(N)	a thing that you buy to remind you of a place that you have visited	He brought us a lot of <b>souvenirs</b> from the United States.
<b>incredible</b>	(ADJ)	extremely good, great	This picture is <b>incredible</b> !
<b>broadcasting</b>	(N)	the business of sending out programs on a radio or television	My friend works for a <b>broadcasting</b> company.
