Exercise 01

Vocabulary

discount	(N.)	an amount of money taken off the regular price	There is a fifty percent discount on all items in the store.
shopaholic	(N.)	a person who enjoys shopping and spends too much time or money on it	She is a shopaholic . She spends most of her salary on shopping.
window-shopping	(N.)	the activity of looking at things in shops without buying anything	One of my hobbies is window-shopping .
window-shopper	(N.)	a person who window-shops	He is just a window-shopper . He doesn't buy anything.
up to	(PHRASE)	used to express the maximum amount of something	The price is reduced up to 20%.
run out of	(PHRV)	if you run out of something you have no more of it left	That shopping mall always runs out of stock.
