### Exercise 01

### Vocabulary

<b>broom</b>	(N)	a brush with a long handle used for sweeping floors	We need a <b>broom</b> to clean up this broken glass.
<b>witch</b>	(N)	a woman who has magic powers that she uses to do bad things	Do you think <b>witches</b> really exist?
<b>creepy</b>	(ADJ)	scary and strange	I hate insects. They are so <b>creepy</b> .
<b>haunted</b>	(ADJ)	believed to be visited by ghosts	They say that house is <b>haunted</b> .
<b>bunny</b>	(N)	a rabbit	She appeared in the party with a <b>bunny</b> costume.
<b>brilliant</b>	(ADJ)	very good	She came up with a <b>brilliant</b> idea for the project.
<b>just around the corner</b>	(PHRASE)	very near, going to happen soon	Your birthday is <b>just around the corner</b> .

Celine

Halloween is just around the corner.



Jess

**Celine**

I'll probably dress as a witch, but don't copy me.



**Jess**

Okay. Hmm... should I be a ghost?



**Celine**

Well, it seems a bit boring. I mean, it's probably too simple to make a ghost costume, don't you think?



**Jess**

Yes, you are right. Then I'll be a bunny.



**Celine**

Wow, a bunny girl!? Brilliant idea! Anyway, I have to go and buy a few more things. I still need a witch's hat and broom.



**Jess**

Okay. By the way, where will the party be held?





Celine

It will be at Oat's place. He said he would try to decorate it as a haunted house.



Jess

So cool! Okay, I'll wear a cute bunny costume. See you.



Celine

See you, bunny!
